
- When assembling, **do not tighten hardware completely.**
- SuperATV has found that installing components to windshields on a workbench, as shown in illustrations, makes for easiest installation.

Lower Windshield (B)


- Install provided Seal to Lower Windshield (B).




- Install Catch, part of Latch Assembly (D), to Lower Windshield (B); place Latch Support (J) on bottom section of Lower Windshield (B) and secure with hardware shown.



- Install Lower Support R (K) to Lower Windshield (B) and Clamp (F) with hardware shown.
- Repeat for opposite side.




- Install Lower Windshield (B) assembly to Cage.
- Secure Clamps (F) with hardware provided with Clamps (F).
- Install provided Gasket to Lower Windshield (B) as shown.




Upper Windshield (A)


- Install Pivot Blocks (E) to Upper Windshield (A) with hardware shown.
- Install Handle and Support, part of Latch Assembly (D), to Upper Windshield (A) with hardware shown.
- Repeat for opposite side.





- Install Upper Support L (H) to Pivot Block (E) with hardware shown.
- Install Gas Strut (C) to Upper Support L (H) with hardware shown.
- Install Clamp (F) to Upper Support L (H) with hardware shown.
- Repeat for opposite side.



- Install Clamps (F) to Cage as shown.



- Install Upper Supports (H-G) to Clamps (F) with hardware shown.
- Secure lower most Clamps (F) to Cage as shown.



- Open Upper Windshield and secure Gas Struts (C) to Pivot Blocks (E) with hardware shown.
- Close Upper Windshield and engage Latch.
- Align Windshield assembly to machine making sure that Seal, on Lower Windshield (B), is in contact with Hood.
- Tighten hardware completely.

Windshield Cleaning:

- Do not use window cleaning fluids (Windex, 409, etc) or any solvents (gasoline, denatured alcohol, acetone, etc).
 - Never use abrasive cleaners, abrasive pads, or gritty cloths.
 - Never use razor blades, scrapers, squeegees, brushes, etc.
1. Thoroughly rinse Windshield to float off dirt and mud.
 2. Using a soft cloth, or microfiber cloth, clean Windshield with warm water and a gentle detergent. Baby shampoo or hand washing soap are recommended.
 3. To prevent water spots, use a chamois to blot Windshield dry.
